Choice likely to stir younger workers

Younger workers are most likely to change funds under the new choice of superannuation fund regime, a survey by Woolcott Research on behalf of FuturePlus Financial Services shows. Almost half of those aged 25 to 34 said they were likely to change funds over the next 12 to 18 months. By contrast, almost 80 per cent of those over 55 said they would probably stay put. FuturePlus warned against reading too much into the results, however, saying many young people were unlikely to act on their stated intentions.
